## CHANGES IN INCOME DISTRIBUTION PATTERNS, WEALTH, AND POVERTY AMONG NEW YORK CITY'S RACIAL/ETHNIC GROUPS BETWEEN 1999 AND 2004

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# Changes in Income Distribution Patterns, Wealth, and Poverty among New York City's Racial/Ethnic Groups between 1999 and 2004

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The American Community Survey of 2004 published by the U.S. Census Bureau provides income data which permit the measurement of changes among New York City's principal racial/ethnic groups from 1999.<sup>1</sup> These data measure two general groupings of income: household and family both of which will be examined in this report.<sup>2</sup>

## Household Income Patterns

The most striking differential when household income patterns are examined is that among Latino households there was almost no increase in median household income between 1999 and 2004. Among whites, African Americans, and Asians there were significant increases in median household income over this 5-year period. (See figures 1 and table 1).

The data found in this report are not precise measurements of wealth or poverty, but they serve as reliable indicators of differences between New York City's racial/ethnic groups. All tables, figures, and data found in this report are based upon U.S. Census Bureau Summary File 4 for 1999 data; and the American Community Survey 2004. These are found on the Census Bureau website at <http://www.census.gov> and are accessible through American FactFinder.

<sup>2</sup> A household is defined by the census bureau as follows: "A household consists of all the people who occupy a housing unit." A family is defined as follows: "A family is a group of two people or more (one of whom is the householder) related by birth, marriage, or adoption and residing together; all such people (including related subfamily members) are considered as members of one family." 1999 - 2004

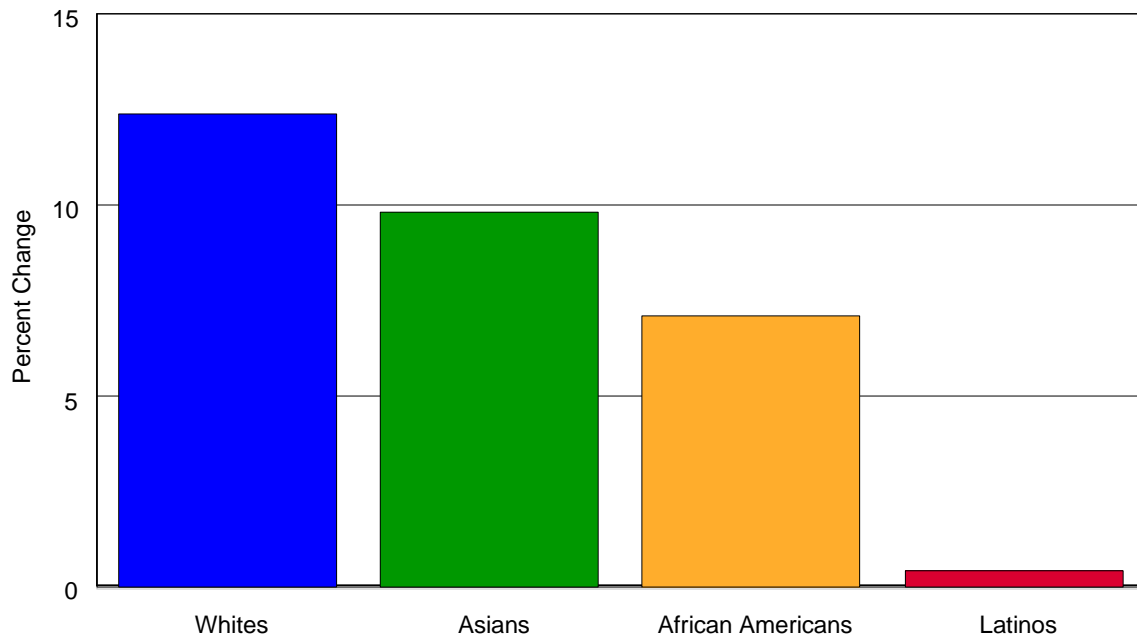

When household income distribution patterns are examined between 1999 and 2004 Latino households not only had the highest percentage of the four principal racial/ethnic earning under \$30,000 annually – over 50% in both years – but there was no change in the percentage of lower income-earning Latino households. Each of the other racial/ethnic groups experienced both a decline in households earning under \$30,000 annually, as well as an increase in those households earning more than \$50,000 annually. Latinos had the smallest proportion of households in the city earning more than \$50,000 annually in 1999 and 2004 and also there was no significant increase in the percentage of Latino households in this income category between these years. Figure 2: Percentage of Households Earning Less than \$30,000 Yearly in NYC by Racial/Ethnic Group, 1999 - 2004

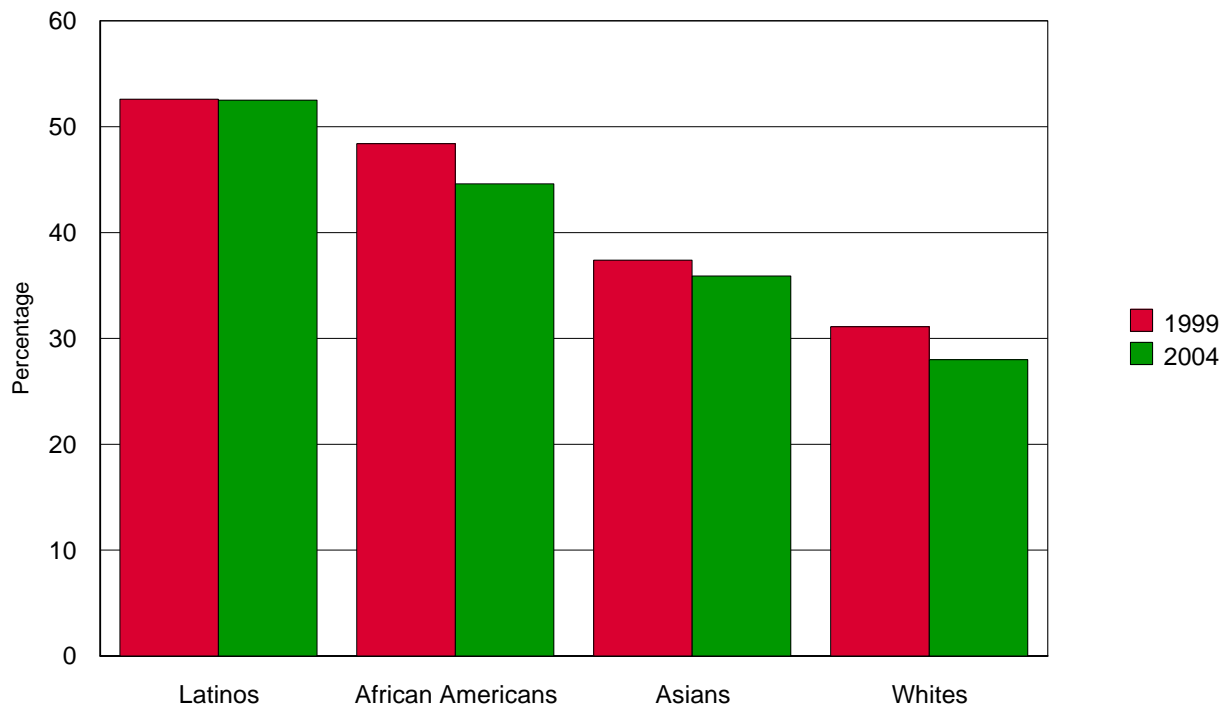
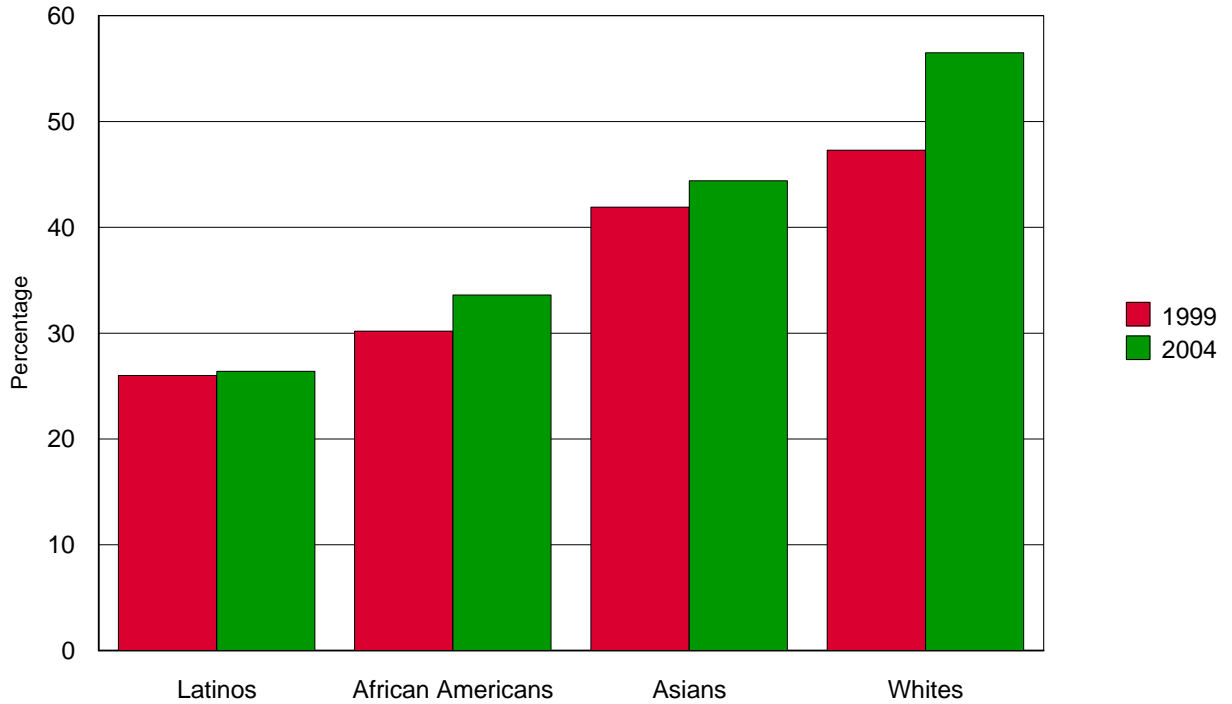


Figure 3: Percentage of Households Earning More than \$50,000 Yearly in NYC by Racial/Ethnic Group, 1999 - 2004



### Family Income Patterns

Comparative family income patterns reveal the same disparities between the racial/ethnic groups. White, African-American, and Asian families in New York City experienced significant increases in family income between 1999 and 2004, while Latino family income in the city rose at a much lower rate. (See figure 4 and table 2).

Figure 4: Percent Change in Family Income Among NYC Racial/Ethnic Groups 1999 - 2004

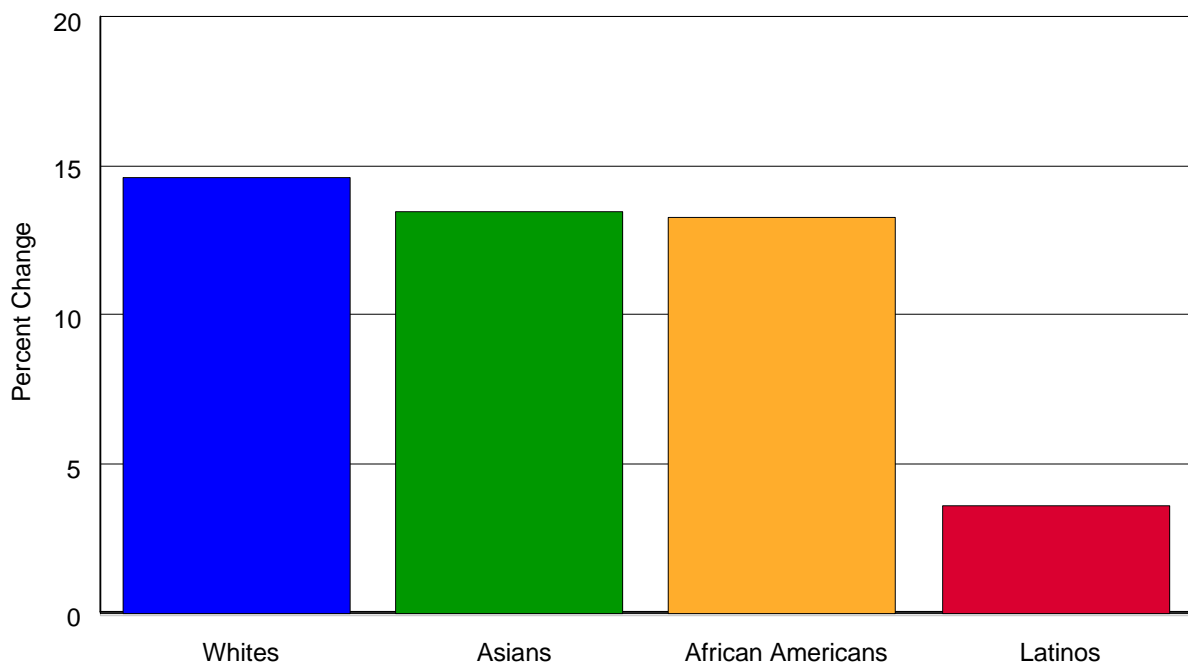

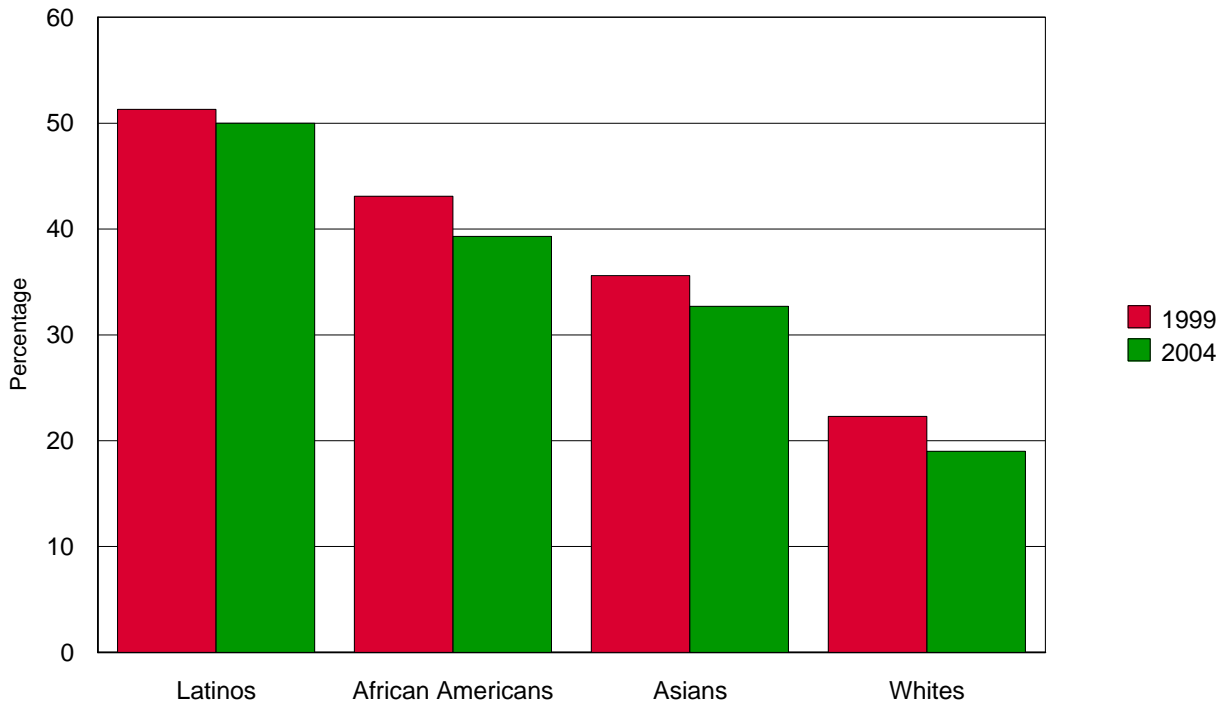
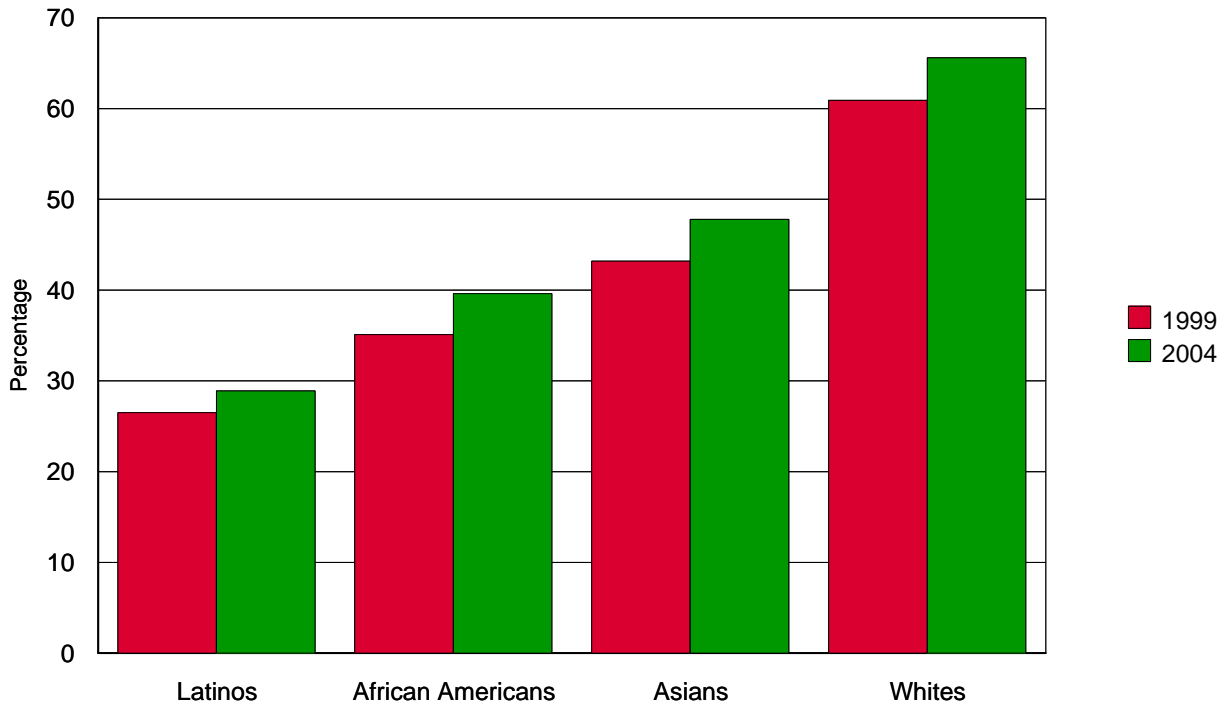


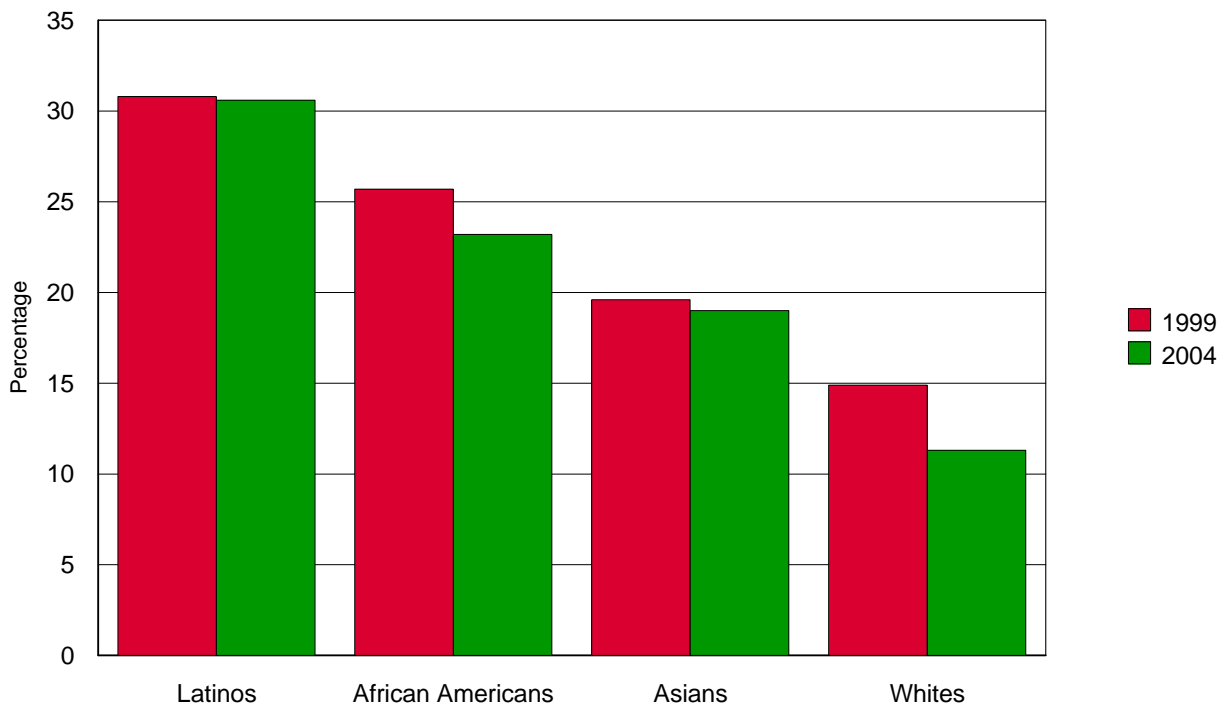
Figure 6: Percentage of Families Earning More than \$50,000 Yearly in NYC by Racial/Ethnic Group, 1999 - 2004

Family income structures among the ethnic groups also validate the household income data observed previously. Latino families in New York City had greater percentages earning under \$30,000 yearly and smaller percentages earning over \$50,000 yearly compared with the other racial/ethnic groups. (See figures 5 and 6).

Figure 5: Percentage of Families Earning Less than \$30,000 Yearly in NYC by Racial/Ethnic Group, 1999 - 2004

**Poverty**

In both 1999 and 2004 greater percentages of Latinos lived in poverty in New York than among the other racial/ethnic groups. There were slight declines in the poverty rates among African-Americans, Asians, and Whites. Yet among Latinos the percentage of the population living in poverty remained about the same at about 30%. (See Figure 7)

## Per Capita Income

Per capita income data for 1999 and 2004 also indicate that Latinos were New York City's poorest inhabitants. Although there were slight increases in income per capita among all racial/ethnic groups between 1999 and 2004, Latinos lagged behind Whites, African Americans, and Asians in absolute terms. (See Figure 8 and Table 3).

by Racial/Ethnic Group, 1999 - 2004

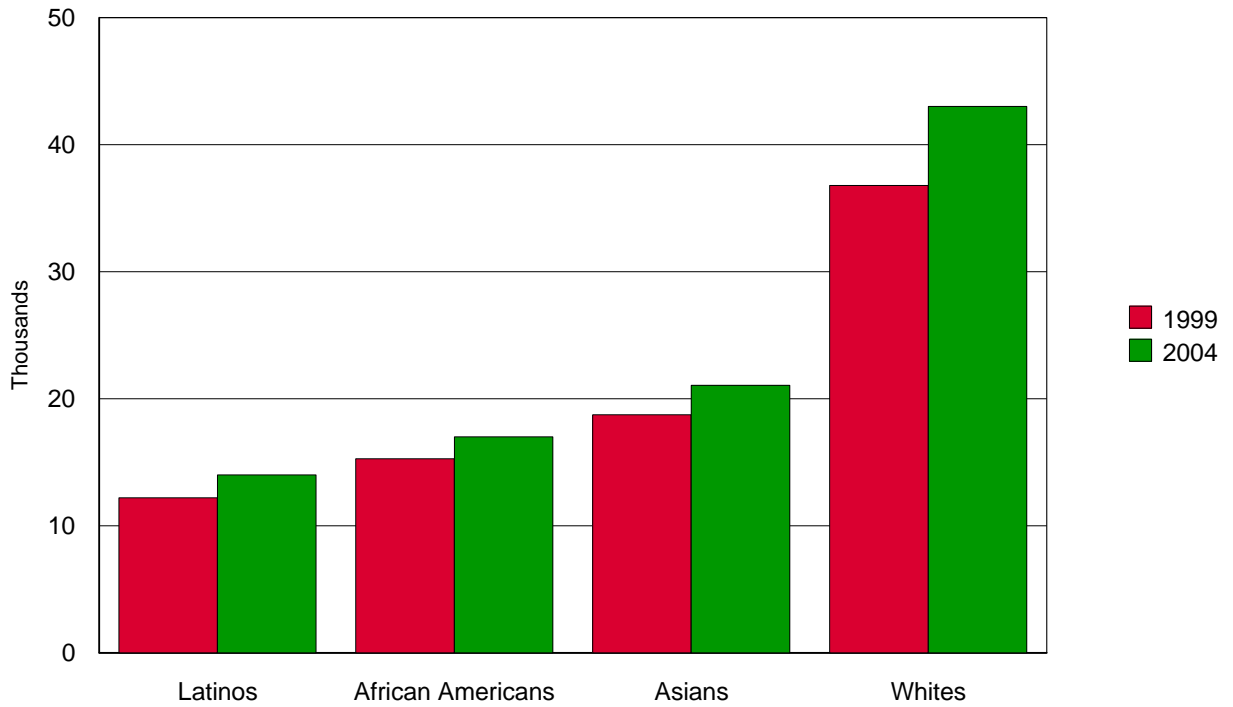

While Latinos continue to make up the poorest sectors of New York City's population, it should be emphasized that they are not homogenous either from the perspectives of national origins or income distribution structures.<sup>3</sup> Data from the 2004 American Community Survey are not available on household income or family income by national group among Latinos. However, it should be noted that while poverty and low household or family incomes continue to plague a good portion of the Latino community, there was also clear evidence of wealth and middle income sectors of significant proportions and a marked degree of social stratification. Over one-quarter of all Latino families and households earned over \$50,000 annually.

Complete income distribution data on New York City households and families by racial/ethnic group between 1999 and 2004 are provided in the Statistical Appendix.

<sup>3</sup> Of the over 2,200,000 Latinos estimated to comprise the city's Latino population in 2004, 38% were Puerto Rican, 23% Dominican, 11% Mexican, 7% Ecuadorian, and 4% Colombian.
